Online Federal Tax Payments The Electronic Federal Tax Payment System (EFTPS) is the easiest and fastest way to pay your Federal Taxes. When you use EFTPS-Online to make payments for your company or your clients, you have the ability to review and sort payment history, check payment status, and make enrollment information changes online and more. It is simple to navigate through the online site, and the site is secure with both a PIN and Internet password combination. You can access EFTPS 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to initiate all your federal tax payments from the convenience of your home or office.

Here's What You Need to Know About EFTPS

EFTPS is a tax payment system offered free from the U.S. Department of the Treasury, designed for business owners in mind. Using the Internet, Personal Computer (PC software) or phone, you can make your tax payment faster and easier without any unnecessary trips. You're in total control of initiating your tax payment securely through this site. It's that simple! If you prefer to use your PC, you can receive free EFTPS Windows® based software that's easy to install and use.

You choose the method of payment

When you enroll in EFTPS, you can select how you want to make your payments. There are two primary payment methods with EFTPS. You can select one or both methods:

- EFTPS – Direct (ACH Debit)
This is available to both individual and business taxpayers, EFTPS – Direct also offers the taxpayer the most flexibility.
- EFTPS – Through a financial institution (ACH Credit)
This is available only to business taxpayers. At this time, Bethpage does not offer this option.

Enrollment

To enroll in EFTPS you must complete the online New Taxpayer Enrollment Form. You should have the following information ready:

- Your Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN)
 - For businesses, this is your EIN (Employer Identification Number)
 - For individuals, this is your SSN (Social Security Number).
- You will also need to complete the name, address, and telephone number information on the New Taxpayer Enrollment Form.

All EFTPS materials and correspondence will be mailed to the IRS address of record. This is the address on file with the IRS as it appears on your tax returns or IRS documents.

Your email address is optional. But should EFTPS – Online ever need to contact you immediately regarding an update or change, your email address will come in handy. Your email address will not be shared with anyone.

You input and verify all of the information. After all your information is validated, you will be presented with an Enrollment Confirmation page that includes an Enrollment Trace Number. You will be requested to print this page for your records.

Within 15 business days your Personal Identification Number (PIN) will be mailed to your IRS Address of Record. You will also receive Confirmation materials including instructions on how to obtain your Internet Password for secure use of EFTPS-Online.

Enroll today and begin using electronic federal tax payments

EFTPS – Direct (ACH Debit)

EFTPS – Direct is an electronic payment method that allows you to access EFTPS directly to report your tax information. You will instruct EFTPS to move the funds from your account to the Treasury's account on the date you indicate. Funds will not move from your account until the date you indicate, (no government agency has access to your account), and your tax records will be updated with the IRS. You can initiate your payment directly to EFTPS using the Internet, PC, or your phone.

With EFTPS – Direct all 3 methods are interchangeable. Use the Internet at the office, the PC at home, or the phone if you're on vacation. All EFTPS input methods are interchangeable and can be used as back up.

Here's How EFTPS – Direct Works:

- Step 1 – At least one calendar day prior to your tax due date, before 8:00 PM ET, you access EFTPS by Internet, PC software, or phone. EFTPS will prompt you for the necessary information to complete your tax payment
- Step 2 – The system processes the information reported, and when accepted, you receive an Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Acknowledgement Number that you should keep for your records in case of any questions at a later date.
- Step 3 – Once your tax payment instructions are accepted, EFTPS will originate an ACH debit transaction against your designated account on the date you indicated when you made your tax payment.
- Step 4 – The funds will be transferred to the Treasury's account and the tax data will be reported to the IRS to update your tax records.

EFTPS – Bethpage Does Not Offer (ACH Credit) At This Time

EFTPS can be used by business taxpayers with certain financial institution accounts. Not all financial institutions offer this service. Bethpage does not offer EFTPS through (ACH Credit) at this time.

Security Is EFTPS Secure?

For you to use EFTPS – Direct, you will receive a Personal Identification Number (PIN).

Your PIN must be used in combination with your Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) to gain access to EFTPS by Internet, PC software, or phone.

You have complete and exclusive control over your PIN. The government does not have access to your PIN.

If you use EFTPS Online, you will also be issued a password that together with your PIN and TIN gives you maximum security online.
